# Notice to Suppliers (NTS).

## Purpose & Structure.

- **Notices to Suppliers is a process used by Rolls-Royce Business Units to formally communicate information quickly to the global supplier network.**
- **NTS's utilise a common / consecutive numbering system and (regardless of originating source) are normally subject to a pre-issue review by those participating Rolls-Royce Business Units to ensure all respective needs or limitations are covered / clearly specified, prior to formal authorisation and final publication on our Suppliermanager-online.com website (Please refer to SABRe - Control of Documents & Records for additional detail).**
- **Each NTS carries a unique number and will normally be a "one shot document" - in the event that of any subsequent content revision being required this will result in a freshly numbered document being issued which may in turn make reference to any preceding NTS's - as / where necessary.**
- **Where appropriate, the content of an NTS may be subsequently absorbed within the framework of a corresponding SABRe topic and the original NTS withdrawn accordingly.**



# Notice to Suppliers (NTS).

## Scope.

All NTS's will carry a clear statement of scope which may be :

- **Applicable to all Rolls-Royce Business Units and their global suppliers - this will normally apply, unless otherwise indicated.**
- **Applicable to specific Rolls-Royce Business Units only (e.g. Rolls-Royce Corporation, Rolls-Royce Deutschland, Rolls-Royce Marine - Submarines etc.) and their respective supplier networks.**
- **Applicable to specific Rolls-Royce products (e.g. Engine Types).**
- **Applicable to a specific category of business (e.g. Repair & Overhaul).**
- **Applicable to a specific category or range of suppliers by product type (e.g. Castings, Forgings, Fabrications, Control Systems etc.)**
- **Applicable to specific business (e.g. commercial / technical) processes.**



# Notice to Suppliers (NTS).

## Objective.

Rolls-Royce may use NTS's to :

- Advise on any Health, Safety, or Environmental requirements which may impact on our respective business.
- Advise on any regulatory (e.g. Airworthiness) Issues.
- As a means of formally communicating urgent issues requiring supplier action (material / product / process over-check etc.).
- Communicating urgent process / specification issues normally lodged in SABRe which arise between updates of the latter.
- Advising on impending changes to business interface (e.g. Commercial / Technical) arrangements.

In all the above cases where any action is required by the supplier network, this will be clearly specified within the relevant NTS.
